of international competitions in freestyle and women's wrestling among juniors and female juniors born in 2003 – 2005, in memory of the Olympic champion, Honored Master of Sports of the USSR, Honored coach of Russia, USSR,

**Roman Mikhailovich Dmitriev,**

dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the physical culture movement in Yakutia

### 1. Goals and objectives

- Perpetuation of the memory of the Honored Master of Sports of the USSR, Honored Coach of the USSR, Olympic Champion Roman Mikhailovich Dmitriev;
- Promotion and popularization of freestyle wrestling;
- Improvement of sports skills;
- Cooperation with friendly countries.

### 2. Dates and venue

The tournament is held from March 10 to March 12, 2023 in Yakutsk in the CSP "Triumph", at the address: Yakutsk, Oyunsky str., 26. Arrival day is March 10, 2023.

### **3. Management of the competition**

The general management is carried out by the Ministry of Sports of the Russian Federation, the Wrestling Federation of Russia, the Ministry of Physical Culture and Sports of the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia), the Wrestling Federation of the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia), GBPOU RS (Ya) "Republican School (College) of the Olympic Reserve named after R.M. Dmitriev". The direct conduct of the competition is assigned to the judging panel.

### **4. Participants and the order of the competition**

The tournament is a personal competition, and is held according to the current UWW rules in the junior weight categories 57, 61, 65, 70, 74, 79, 86, 92, 97, 125 kg., and 50, 53, 55, 57, 59, 62, 65, 68, 72, 76 kg.in female junior categories, a tolerance of 2 kg is allowed.

### **5. Requirements for participants and conditions of their admission**

According to the “Regulations on the organization and conduct of official physical culture and sports events on the territory of the Russian Federation under the conditions of remaining risks of the spread of COVID-19 infection”, approved by the order of the Ministry of Sports of Russia and Rospotrebnadzor dated from 31.06.2020, with additions and amendments, admission of all participants of the competition is carried out if they



have the result certificate of laboratory testing for a new coronavirus infection (COVID-19) by polymerase chain reaction (PCR), conducted no earlier than 72 hours before arrival at the venue of the event.

## **6. Awarding.**

Participants who won 1st, 2nd, two 3rd (third) places are awarded with medals, diplomas and a cash prize in the amount of:

1st place – 35,000 rubles,

2nd place – 25,000 rubles,

3rd places – 15,000 rubles.

The coach who trained the champion is also awarded a cash prize in the amount of 10,000 rubles .

Total prize fund is 2,000,000 (two million) rubles, including income tax.

Cash prize will be paid to the winners and prize-winners on presenting of a passport, Tax Identification Number , insurance (or pension) certificate. Special prizes from sponsors are intended.

## **7. Financing.**

The costs of the competition are borne by the Ministry of Sports of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Physical Culture and Sports of the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia), sponsors.

## **8. Applications**

- Applications are submitted on the day of arrival to the mandate commission.
- Certificates and preliminary applications indicating the number of participants are submitted before March 01, 2023.
